Thank you to all parents who returned their parent questionnaire. 60 questionnaires were returned and the questionnaires were extremely positive. 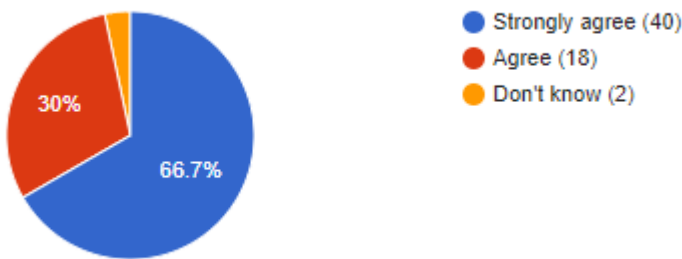

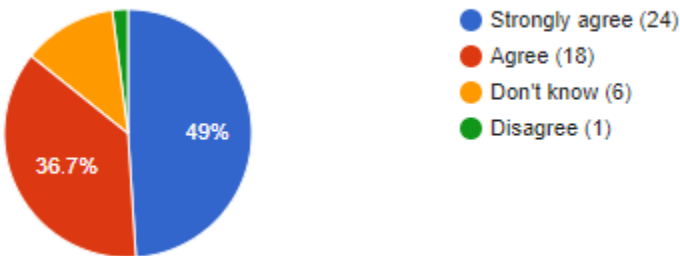
