

# **Admission criteria for Reception admissions**

## **Admissions to Reception**

Admissions to Reception are administered by the London Borough of Barnet and places to the Reception classes are allocated according to Barnet's admission criteria:

- ☆ Children for whom a Statement of Special Educational Needs has been made since 1996 or is likely to be made and for whom the school has been named in that statement or is likely to be named.
- ☆ Children whom the Chief Education Officer accepts have an exceptional medical, social or educational need which the school is particularly able to meet. This will include children 'looked after' by the London Borough of Barnet.
- ☆ Presence of a sibling in the school or in the linked Junior School.
- ☆ Children of teaching staff of the school where the member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made and will be in employment as a teacher at the school when the child starts school.
- ☆ Proximity and location of the child's home in relation to the school of preference and all other community schools in the area.
