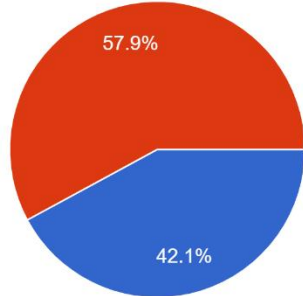

My child is happy at school

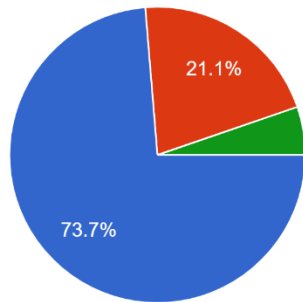

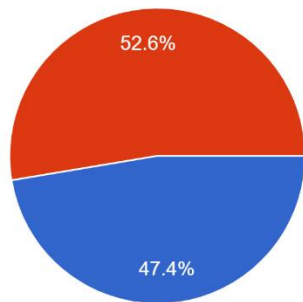

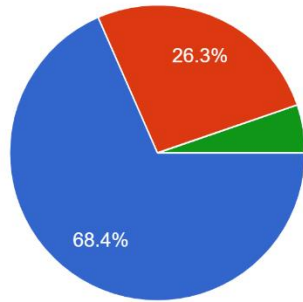

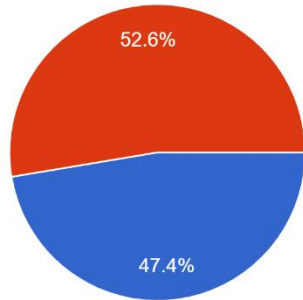

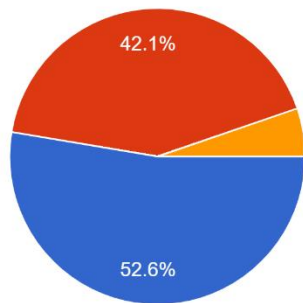

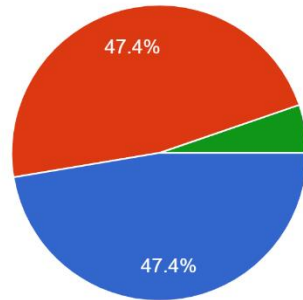

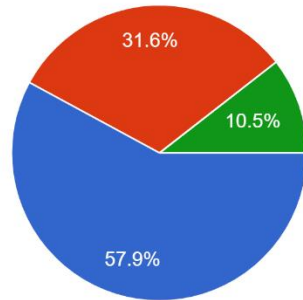

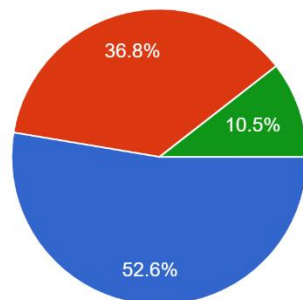
