Applying for Reception for 2026-2027

Children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 (all current Nursery pupils) are due to start Reception in September 2026.

Parents and carers must submit one online application through their home local authority for all state-funded school places (excluding private schools), regardless of whether the schools are located within or outside Barnet. Applications should be made at www.eadmissions.org.uk.

Before beginning your application, we strongly recommend downloading "A Guide to Primary Education in Barnet" from www.barnet.gov.uk/schooladmissions. This guide provides essential information about the admissions process, including the admissions criteria used to allocate school places. Please also check the relevant local authority website if you wish to apply for schools outside Barnet, as admissions criteria may vary.
