Hello everyone.

The children have really enjoyed reading our Focus Book, The Train Ride, and, of course, all the Thomas the Tank Engine stories too. They have made trains with various construction toys, junk and collage as well as lining up chairs to create their own trains.

They have continued to explore the Number 2 by adding two items to their [real] sandcastles and have been searching for sets of two objects both inside and outside.

On Tuesday, we looked at the book, Elmer, for Inclusion Day. The children actively recalled the key elements of the story and could talk about the differences and similarities between Elmer and his elephant friends.
