


















Gold Book

What will happen on Christmas Party Day and Pantomime

Soon it will be Christmas Party Day at school. This is a special day, and some things will be a little different. It is okay if I feel excited, unsure, or need extra help.

In the Morning

- When I come to school, I can wear a **festive jumper** if I want to.
- My jumper might feel different from my usual clothes. That is okay.
- Other children and teachers might wear festive jumpers too.

The Classroom

- In the morning, we will follow our usual routines and I can also check on the timetable what will be happening (we will still have time to play, learn, and follow our routines).

- There might be decorations, music, or people feeling excited.
- If I need a quiet moment, I can ask an adult and use a calm space.

The Christmas Party

- We might have party games, dancing, or special snacks.
- I can join in if I want to.
- If I don't want to join something, I can watch, take a break, or ask for help.

The Pantomime (Afternoon)

- In the afternoon, we will go to the pantomime in the hall.
- A pantomime is a fun show with acting, singing, and sometimes silly jokes.
- It might be loud. There might be clapping, cheering, or music.
- If the noise feels too loud, I can use:
 - ear defenders
 - my hands over my ears
 - a quiet space with an adult
- It is okay if I need a break.

Feeling Safe

- Teachers and adults will be there to help me.
- I can tell an adult how I feel.
- It is okay to enjoy the day in my own way.

Going Home

- At the end of the day, I will go home as usual.
- I might feel tired, excited, or ready for quiet time. All feelings are okay.

Nut-Free School (this also includes after school clubs)



We would like to remind all parents and carers that our school is strictly *nut free* in order to keep children with severe nut allergies safe. This includes items such as nuts, cashew nuts,

hazelnuts, pistachios, peanut puffs, hazelnut spread biscuits or dip pots, and other products containing nuts, including pesto, Nutella and Bamba snacks.

While nut allergies are not airborne, there is a significant risk from traces left on hands, play equipment, or classroom surfaces, which could cause a serious reaction in children with allergies.
