- **5.3.26** - World book day - dress up as a word

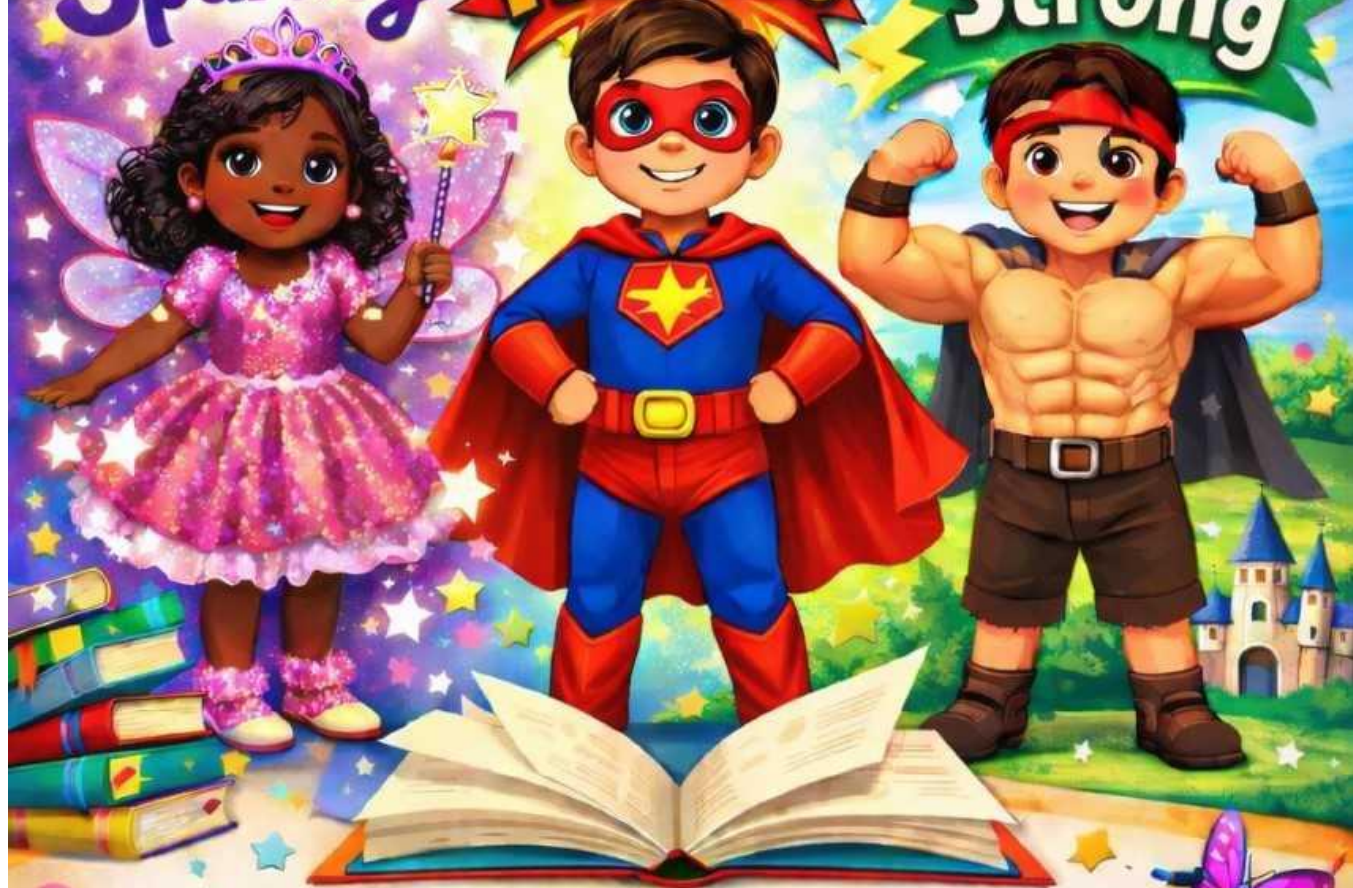

World Book Day Author Visit

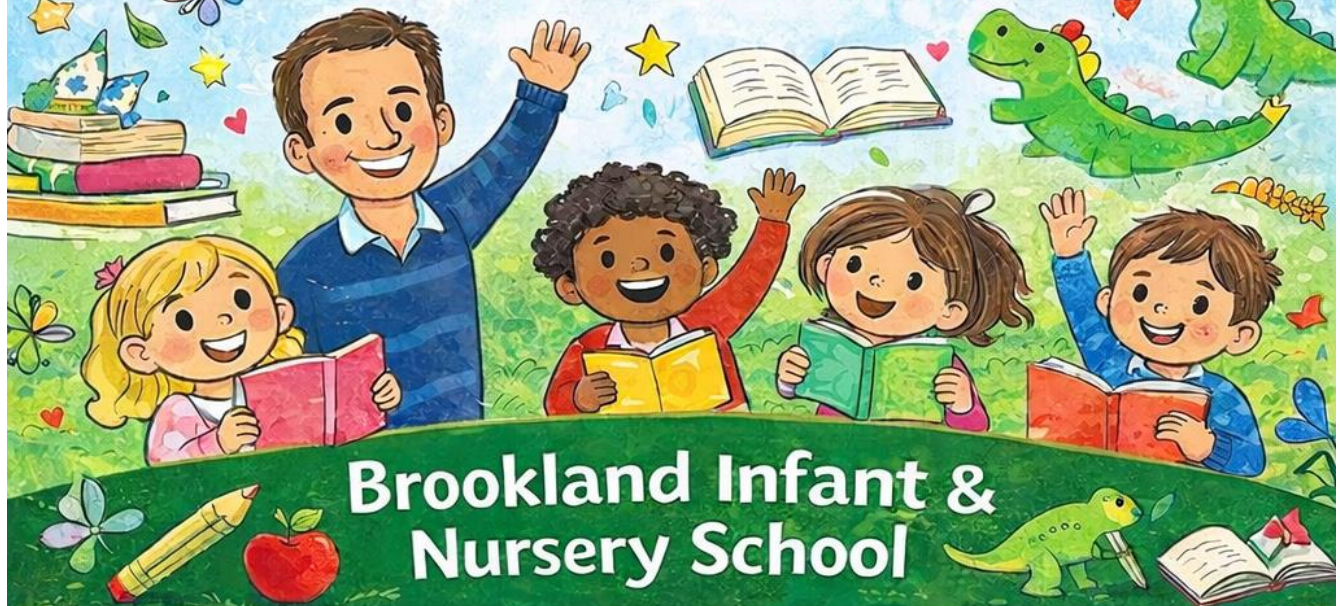
Jason Korsner
