Hanging out the clothes;

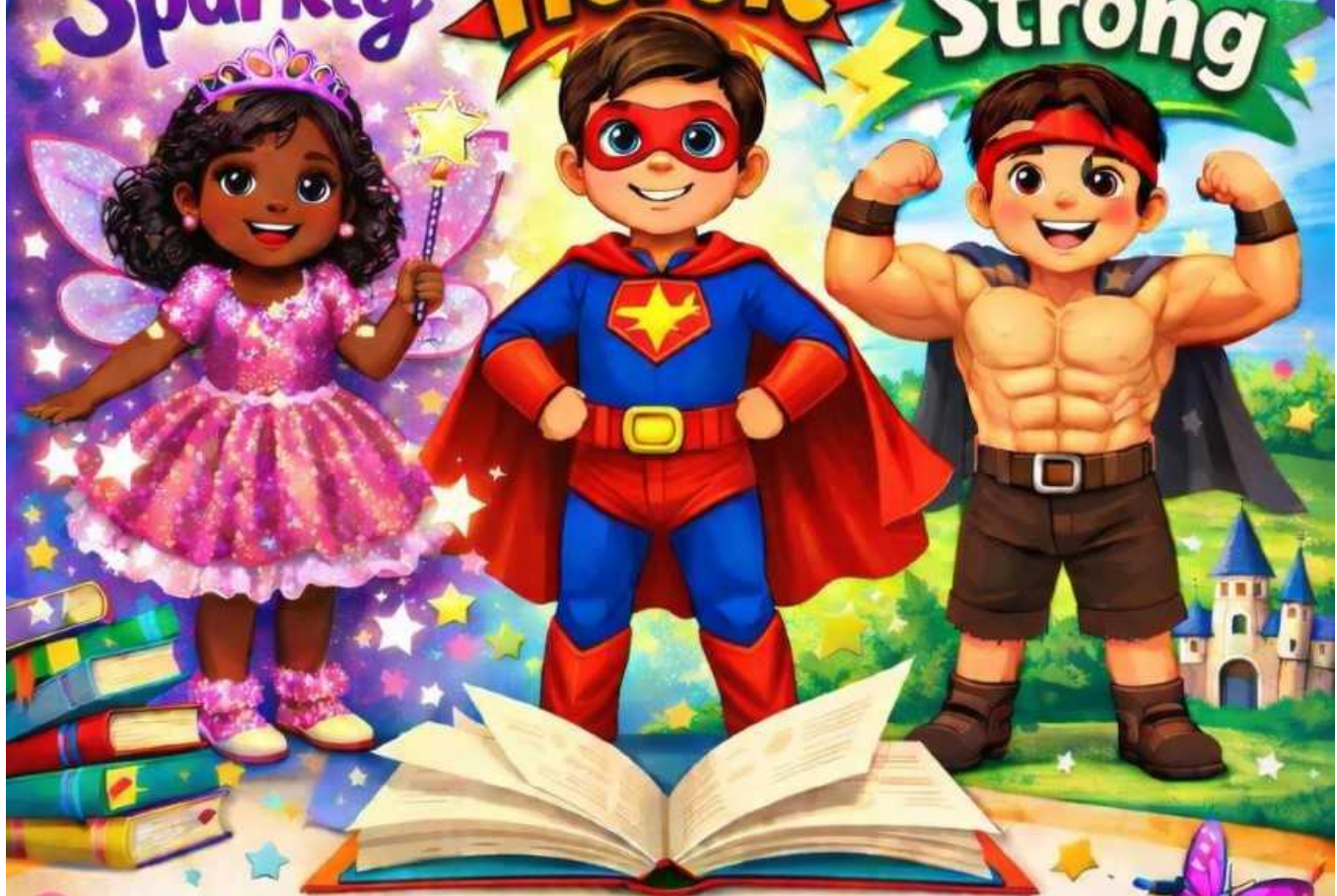
When down flew a blackbird
