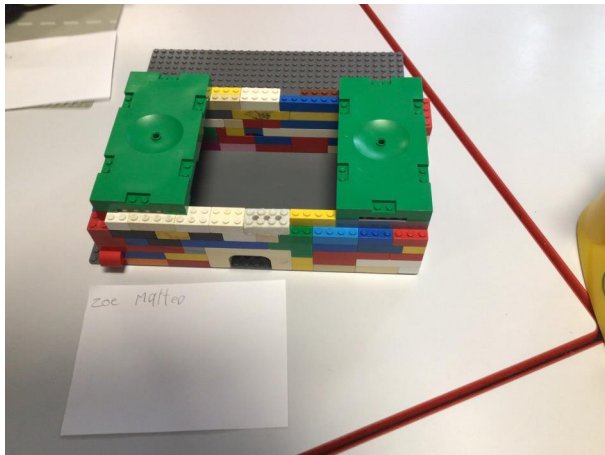


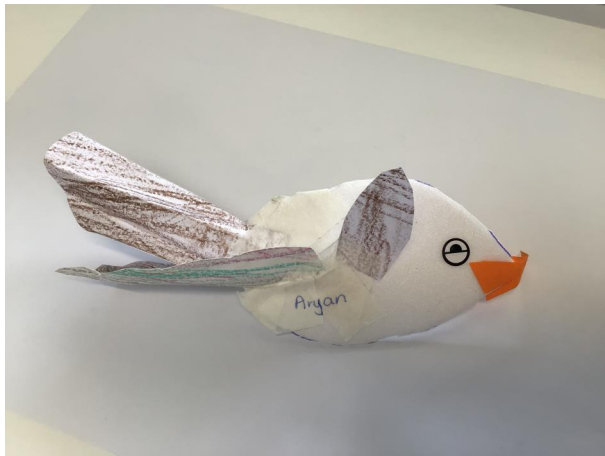














Eid

We Wished each other happy Eid by kissing hand and putting Ji on our forehead.

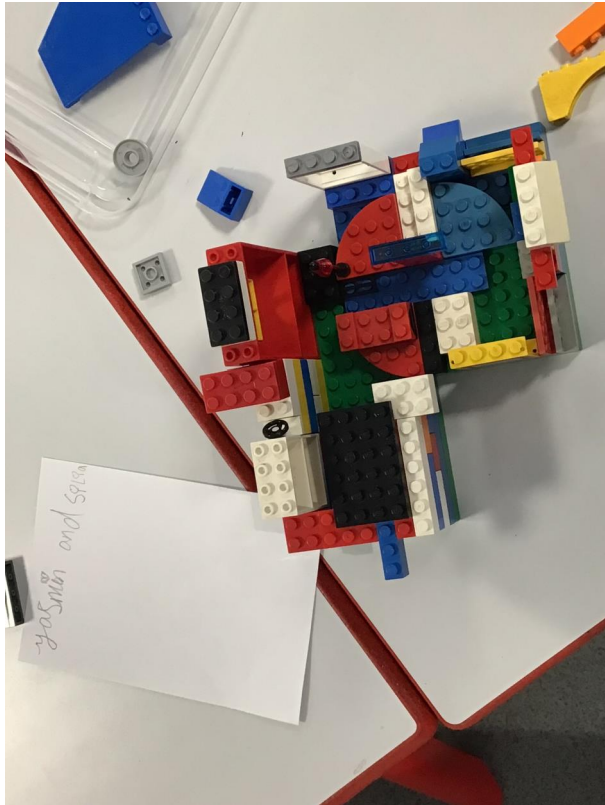
We had special breakfast with my family.

- My aunts and cousins was also there and we had lots of fun. Me and my cousins wer playing football.

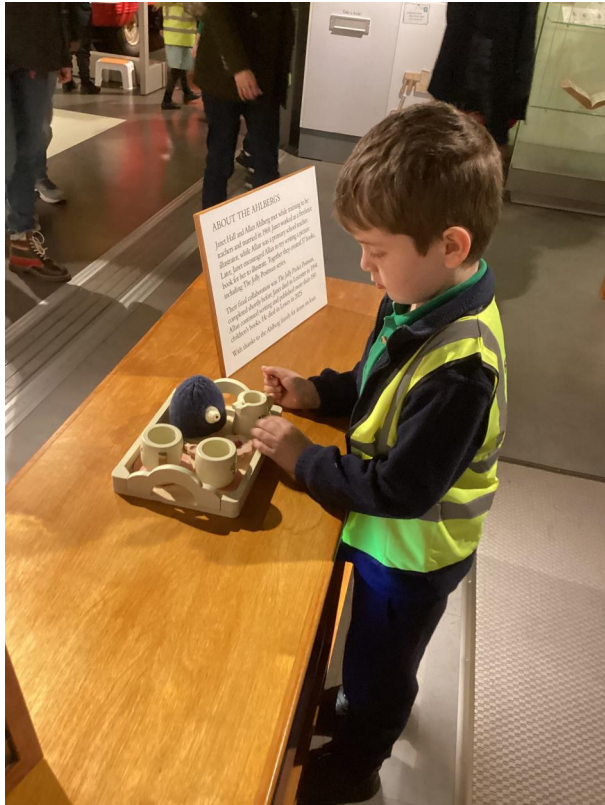




Reception trip to the Postal Museum

Absence Attached to a Holiday

Please note that any absence linked to a holiday will be recorded as unauthorised unless supporting evidence is provided (such as proof of illness or a medical appointment), or the absence has been approved in advance through an Application for Leave of Absence form.

We have also been advised by the Educational Welfare Officer (EWO) that unauthorised absences occurring immediately before or after a holiday may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued.

Screentime Guidance

Recent UK government guidance is offering clear, practical advice to help parents manage screen use for children under five. The new recommendations suggest avoiding screens altogether for under-twos (except for shared, interactive use) and limiting screen time to no more than one hour a day for children aged two to five. The guidance also encourages screen-free routines at mealtimes and before bed, and highlights the importance of watching and talking about content together rather than leaving children to use devices alone. Overall, the focus is on balance, ensuring screens don't replace key early experiences like play, conversation and sleep, which are vital for healthy development. BICS parent workshop on 26th March focused on 'setting healthy boundaries for children'.

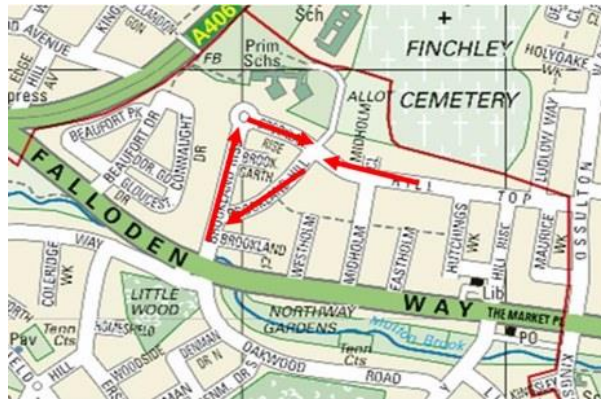
Boundaries create a safe, predictable environment essential for healthy child development and emotional growth.

- We understand that children do often pick up illnesses such as colds, temperatures and other childhood illnesses so this may not always be possible. *When reporting your child's absence, please give us a brief explanation of what your child has so we can comply with public health and attendance guidelines.*
- If your child has an appointment (*hospital, dental, opticians, visa appointment etc*), we do ask that these be made during the half terms. We do understand this may not always be possible, but in any case, proof of the appointment must be provided (e.g screenshot of the reminder text/email, confirmation email/letter etc). **If proof is not seen or provided, the school cannot authorise the absence.**

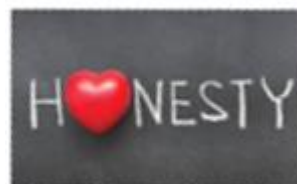
