Topsoil

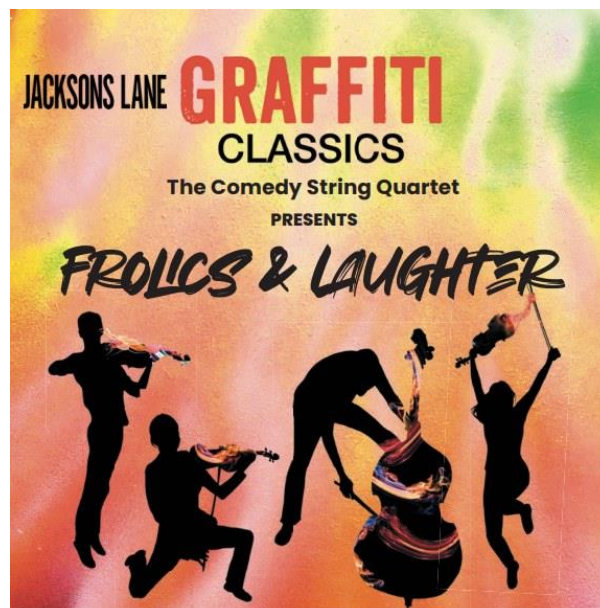

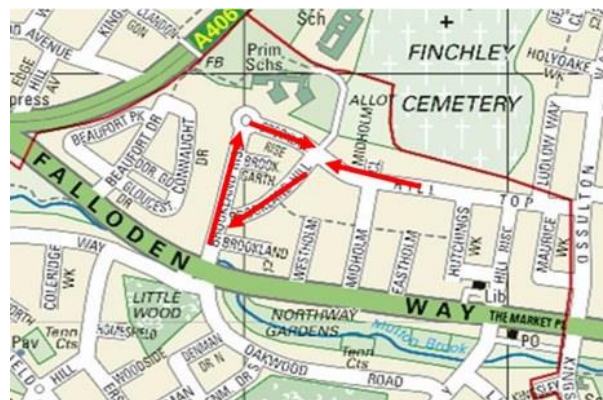
