- If anyone has any carrier bags that they no longer require, we would love them in nursery so that we have something to send wet clothes home in. Thank you.

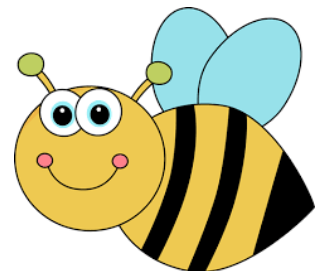
