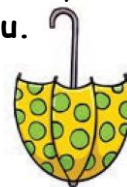

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we read the story 'A Tadpoles Promise' as well as various other frog stories. The children have been really interested in learning about the life cycle of a frog and talking about all the different stages: frogspawn, tadpole, froglet, frog. They loved making frogs using lots of different creative ways and different forms of media. We have also seen a change in our class caterpillars this week, which has been super exciting! We are seeing them moving onto their next stage (chrysalis).

Next week, we will be talking about humans and we have different stages in life from babies to adults. In Maths, we will be focusing on 2D shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle). We will be talking about what these shapes look like and how many sides and corners they have. Our nursery rhyme of the week will be 'ring a ring a roses. In Phonics, our phoneme will be the phoneme u.

Next week, we will be celebrating 'Big Me'. As part of this, the children will be thinking about the job that they would like to do when they are older.
