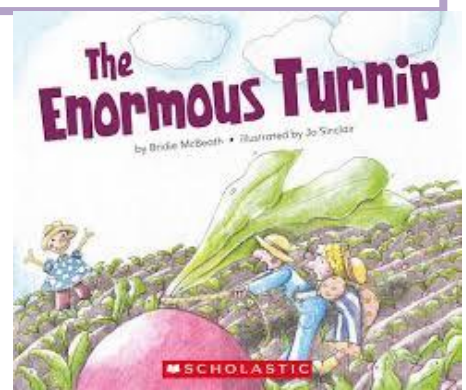

- **Please can parents make any outstanding payments to Nursery Extended Hours and School Lunches by the end of May 2026. Thank you - School Office**

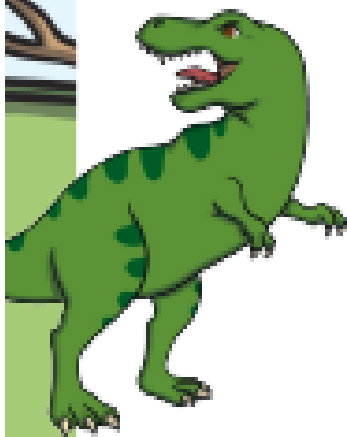

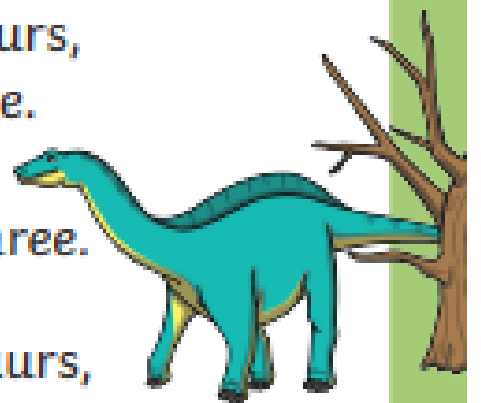
# Five Enormous Dinosaurs

(Say as a spoken rhyme or make up your own tune.)



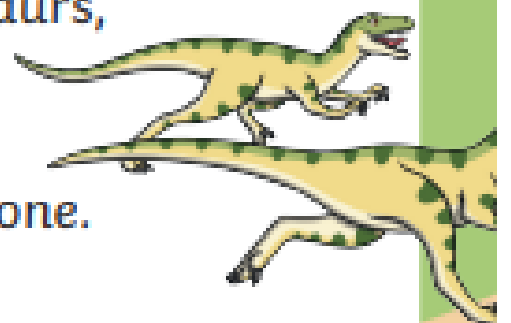
Five enormous dinosaurs,
