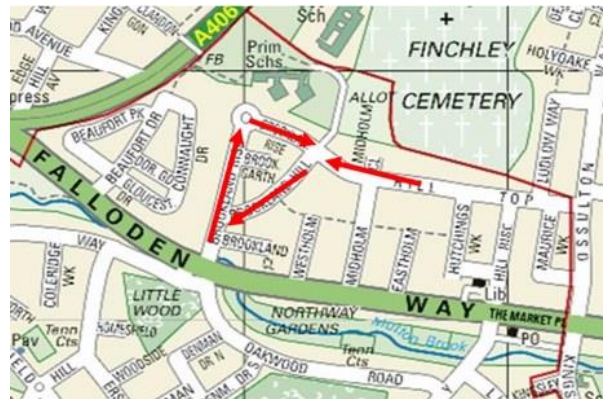

We would like to remind all parents and carers that our school is strictly *nut free* in order to keep children with severe nut allergies safe.
