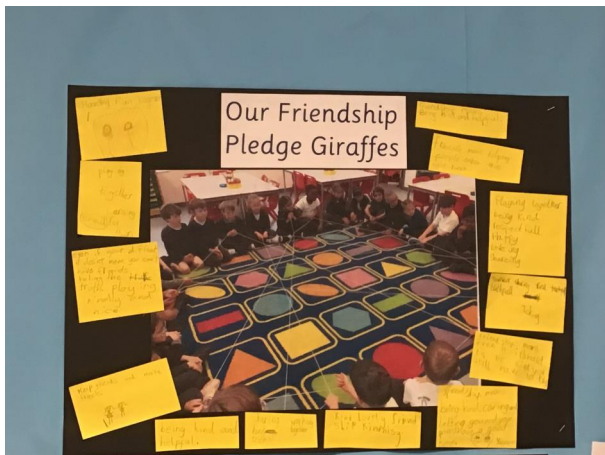

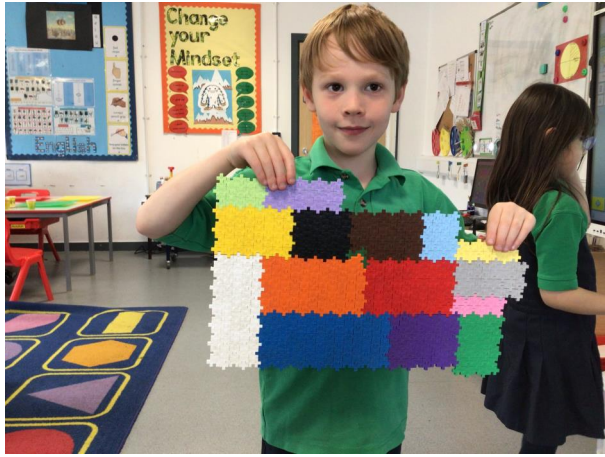














## Gold Book

### **'Dare to be Different'**

It was lovely to see so many of the children coming to school on Monday dressed in their uniform in a different way: there were children with odd socks, odd shoes, dresses on back to front and tops on inside out.

Across the school, everyone was celebrating differences in a positive, fun way to help the children experience the world from different perspectives. Activities included: 'I am unique' self portraits, designing a superhero whose special powers come from being different and a friendship web. Each class designed their own inclusion pledge.

In assembly, we were joined by author Jovita Lall. She read her book, ['Playing Together: Finding Friendship Without Words'](#). It is a heart-warming picture book that celebrates the friendships children can build across differences. It offers a gentle inclusive message about finding common ground and a reminder that connection doesn't need words, just a willingness to play.

## Y1 Phonics Screening Check

### Well Done, Year 1!

I've been so proud of our Year 1 children for their fantastic effort during the Phonics Screening Check. They read so many words—both real and alien—with confidence and enthusiasm. It's a clear sign of the great progress they've made with their reading this year. Their results will be shared with you in their end-of-year reports.

## Sports Day

We are very much looking forward to the Sports Day on Monday 22nd June on the Junior School field up by the Junior School. I have requested nice weather so hopefully this request will be granted. You will receive a letter from your child's class teacher next week letting you know what coloured t-shirt your child needs to wear. We will speak to the children that as much as we love the competition element of Sports Day, we are also there to support our team and celebrate everyone's achievements.

When you arrive to watch Sports Day, please make your way up to the school field and the children will come up with their class. The activities will be set up in the middle of the field and we ask that you keep to the edge of the field while the Sports Day is taking place. Obviously, you will be able to follow your child to each of the activities by moving around the outside of the activities.

## STEM Week

As part of our exciting STEM Week, themed "**The Power of Plants**," we have planned a range of engaging and inspiring activities for the children to enjoy. Throughout the week, children will take part in hands-on learning experiences designed to explore the fascinating world of plants and develop their scientific understanding in a fun and memorable way.

One of the highlights of the week will be a special Science workshop for Key Stage 1. Through interactive role-play and creative performance, the children will participate in the "**Powerful Plants**" educational drama workshop. The programme supports key National Curriculum science objectives, including learning about plant structures, identifying common garden plants, and understanding the conditions plants need to grow and thrive, all while having lots of fun!

The workshop will take place on Tuesday 23rd June, with each Year 1 and Year 2 class enjoying their own dedicated session.

To help cover the cost of the resources and materials purchased to support our STEM Week activities, we kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of **£2.50 per child**. Thank you for your continued support.
