Dear Parents/Carers,

The children have loved looking at the story 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. They have loved writing shopping lists and invitations for our Tiger Tea Party. The children enjoyed designing their own cupcakes and teapots, and of course, they loved decorating their cupcakes to eat at the Tiger's tea party! In Maths, we have recapped composition of numbers within 10.

In Phonics, we have been looking at Phase 4 CVCC words, using their knowledge of Phase 3 diagraphs to support them in reading. In Handwriting, we have been practicing the letter 'f' (Please find attached the handwriting sheet to practice at home).

Next week we are going to be looking at the story 'The Snail and the Whale. In Maths, we are going to be learning about being able to visualise and build. The children will be using different resources to build construction and will be creating maps.

We will be reading sentences. *Can you spot any tricky words? Can you segment and blend the words and look out for this week's phonemes?*

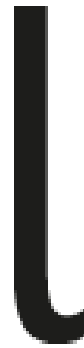
