A big thank you to the PA for providing ice lollies for everyone after the event. They were greatly appreciated, especially in the warm weather.

We are now looking forward to the second part of our Sports Day, which will take place on 13th July from 9:15–10:15am for Reception and Nursery.

STEM Week: The Power of Plants

Despite the heatwave, our Power of Plants STEM Week was a fantastic success, with children across the school enjoying a wide range of exciting and creative activities. A huge thank you goes to Mrs Bradley for organising such a wonderful week and to the parents and carers who volunteered to come in during the week to support activities. The children made seed balls, lavender playdough and herbal tea bags, created beautiful observational drawings of plants and flowers, created stop frame animations of plant life cycles in computing lessons, researched the many uses of plants and wrote informative fact files, and produced some amazing plant-inspired artwork. Year 1 and Year 2 also took part in an engaging drama workshop all about the power of plants. In Science, children labelled large plant diagrams, explored the parts of flowers by carefully pulling apart daisies and other safe flowers, and created botanical sketches. Maths activities included investigating symmetry in flowers, sorting leaves and flowers by size, colour and shape, creating pictograms, and conducting favourite plant surveys which were presented as bar charts. There was so much happening throughout the week, and the children thoroughly enjoyed every opportunity to learn about the importance of plants in our world.

We are looking forward to our Power of Plants Shop next Wednesday after school, where some of the wonderful items the children have made will be available for families to purchase. A few planned activities have had to be postponed, including visits from the Junior

Gardening Club and Dominic Rose from HGS Gardening Club, and we hope to welcome them at a later date.

Owl trip to the Barnet Environmental Centre

Owl Class had a fantastic time on their visit to the Barnet Environmental Centre yesterday. They thoroughly enjoyed taking part in the range of activities and embraced the opportunity to become nature detectives. Despite the warm weather, they did an excellent job of staying as cool as possible while making the most of their outdoor learning experience. 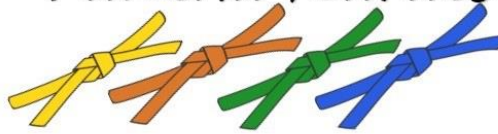

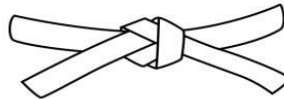

Attendance - Expectations and Information

- We expect a child's attendance to be maintained at 96% or above for the school year.

- If your child has an appointment (*hospital, dental, opticians, visa appointment etc*), we do ask that these be made during the half terms. We do understand this may not always be possible, but in any case, proof of the appointment must be provided (e.g screenshot of the reminder text/email, confirmation email/letter etc). **If proof is not seen or provided, the school cannot authorise the absence.**
- **We will not be able to authorise absences/Leave of Absences on the first or last day of school terms but will take each case in to consideration. Please still complete a Leave of Absence requesting the time as each request will be looked at on their individual merits.**

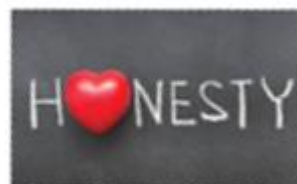

Nut-Free School (this also includes after school clubs)



We would like to remind all parents and carers that our school is strictly *nut free* in order to keep children with severe nut allergies safe. This includes items such as nuts, cashew nuts, hazelnuts, pistachios, peanut puffs, hazelnut spread biscuits or dip pots, and other products containing nuts, including pesto, Nutella and Bamba snacks.

While nut allergies are not airborne, there is a significant risk from traces left on hands, play equipment, or classroom surfaces, which could cause a serious reaction in children with allergies.

We also kindly ask that no nuts or nut-containing items are brought onto the school site at any time, including at pick-up. We have recently noticed children with nuts as a snack to be consumed during their afterschool club activities.
