End of Year Data

We are very pleased to share our end-of-year data with all parents and carers, which reflects how well our children have done this year. Their hard work, progress, and achievements make us incredibly proud.

While we are not yet able to compare our results to national or Barnet figures—as that data has not been released—we are confident that our children have made excellent progress and demonstrated real resilience and commitment throughout the year.

Foundation Stage Profile

Attainment Expectations

At the end of the EYFS the children are defined as having reached a Good Level of Development (GLD). The DfE advise that a GLD has been achieved if children achieve expected in the following areas of learning:

- **Prime areas of learning** - Communication and Language, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development.
- **Specific areas of learning** - Literacy and Mathematics.

70% of our Reception children achieved a Good Level of Development at the end of Reception (2026).

Phonics Screening Check: Year 1

86.4% of our Y1 children achieved the phonics screening check in Year 1 (2026).

Phonics Screening Re – check: Year 2

66.7% of our Y2 children achieved the phonics screening re-check in Year 2 (2026).

End of Key Stage 1

Attainment Expectations

At the end of Key Stage 1 the children are expected to ‘work at’ the expected standard (EXS) for Year 2. GDS means the child is working at greater depth **within** the expected standard for Year 2. As this year is the second year that end of Key Stage 1 assessments are not statutory there is no comparative data for Barnet or National. Please see below our Teacher Assessments for Key Stage 1 in Reading, Writing and Maths.

- **Reading**

78% of our Y2 children are working at the expected standard or above for Year 2 (2026).

31% of our Y2 children are working at greater depth within the expected standard for Year 2 (2026).

- **Writing**

61% of our Y2 children are working at the expected standard or above for Year 2 (2026).

14% of our Y2 children are working at greater depth within the expected standard for Year 2 (2026).

- **Mathematics**

79% of our Y2 children are working at the expected standard or above for Year 2 (2026).

23% of our Y2 children are working at greater depth within the expected standard for Year 2 (2026).

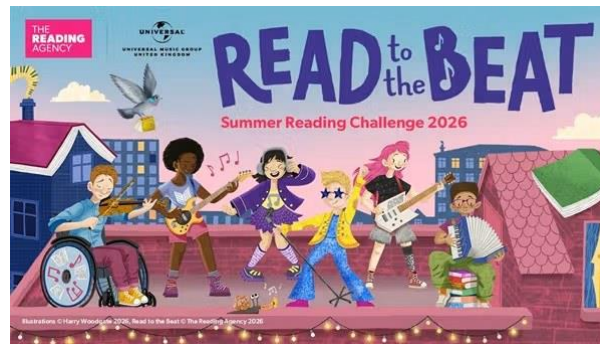

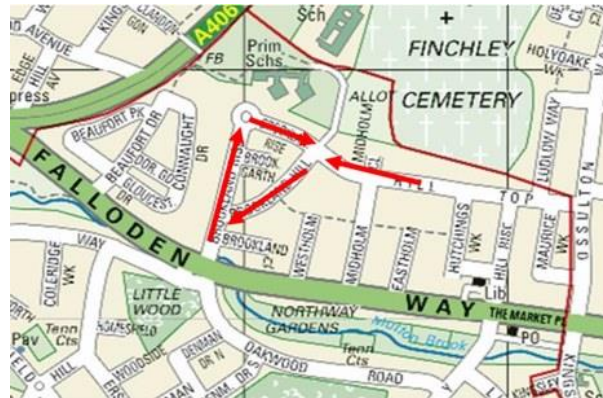
Attendance - Expectations and Information

- We expect a child's attendance to be maintained at 95% or above for the school year.
- We understand that children do often pick up illnesses such as colds, temperatures and other childhood illnesses so this may not always be possible. ***When reporting your child's absence, please give us a brief explanation of what your child has so we can comply with public health and attendance guidelines.***
- If your child has an appointment (*hospital, dental, opticians, visa appointment etc*), we do ask that these be made during the half terms. We do understand this may not always be possible, but in any case, proof of the appointment must be provided (e.g screenshot of the reminder text/email, confirmation email/letter etc). **If proof is not seen or provided, the school cannot authorise the absence.**

We will not be able to authorise any absences or Leave of Absences on the first or last day of school terms but will take each case in to consideration. Please still complete a Leave of Absence requesting the time as each request will be looked at on their individual merits.

We appreciate our parents and carers honesty when it comes to attendance and absences during the school year. We understand there may be events or cases out of your control, but being open and honest with us keeps lines of communication open and enables us to see where we can possibly support in attendance matters.

Nut-Free School (this also includes after school clubs)



We would like to remind all parents and carers that our school is strictly *nut free* in order to keep children with severe nut allergies safe. This includes items such as nuts, cashew nuts, hazelnuts, pistachios, peanut puffs, hazelnut spread biscuits or dip pots, and other products containing nuts, including pesto, Nutella and Bamba snacks.

While nut allergies are not airborne, there is a significant risk from traces left on hands, play equipment, or classroom surfaces, which could cause a serious reaction in children with allergies.

We also kindly ask that no nuts or nut-containing items are brought onto the school site at any time, including at pick-up. We have recently noticed children with nuts as a snack to be consumed during their afterschool club activities.
